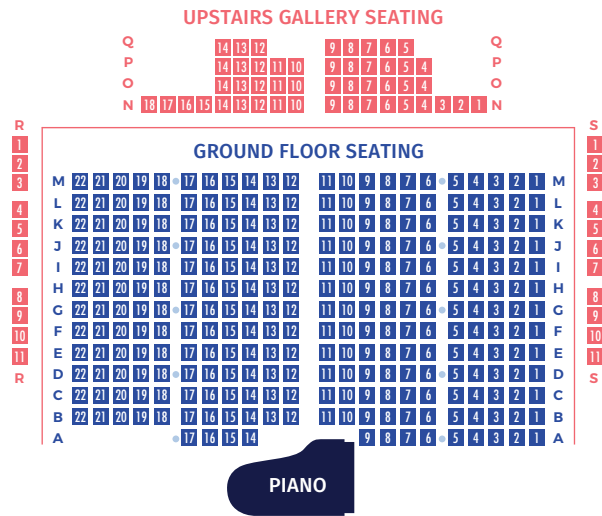


Seating plan

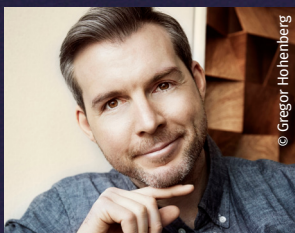
